

Medication and Health Services

(Copy to be kept at home)

- Please note if you indicated on **Health Assessment Form** that your child is **not** taking a medication at home, please use the **Medication Authorization Form** available from your school district online at www.jefco.edu/health-services
- If your child requires medication to be brought to the school, the school medication nurse **is a student carrier for transport** (Such as non-OTC meds)
(Such as non-OTC Class III drugs)
- If your child needs an **INTER-MEDICATION** at school, the **Medication Authorization Form** must be completed and signed by the parent. **OTC** medications may be brought to school without a "Medication Authorization Form" if signed by a doctor. **OTC** meds must be in the original package. Do not bring medication in Ziploc bags, envelope, etc.
- If your child takes a **PRESCRIPTION** medication, the "Medication Authorization Form" must be completed and signed by the doctor and the medication must be labeled by the dispenser with the child's name, date, and medication name, including inhalers.
- If your child requires an **ALLERGY** medication, the **ALLERGY** medication must be in the original package. **EACH SCHOOL** has a **Medication Authorization Form**. This form is available at www.jefco.edu/departments/childnursing
- If your child has a fever (temperature of 100.0 or more) he/she should remain home until **EVER FREE for 24 HOURS**
- If your child has vomiting or diarrhea he/she should be home until **FREE FOR 24 HOURS**
